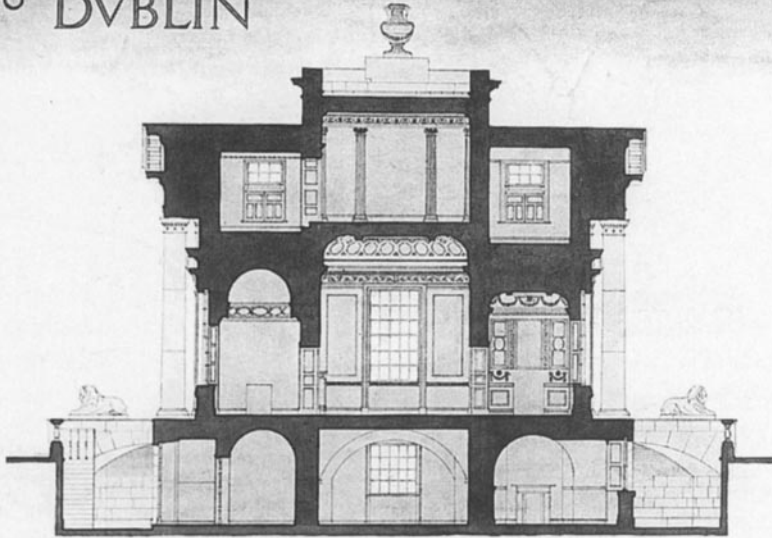


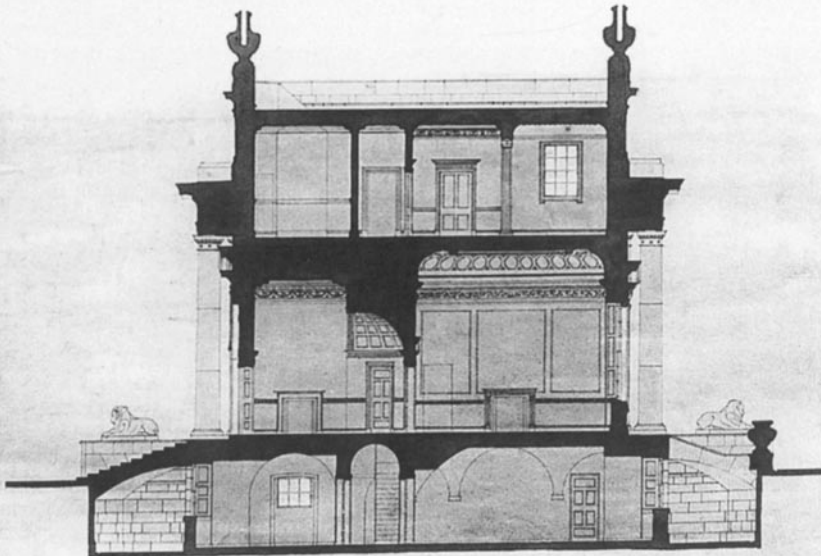

A database of Irish architects 1720-1940: C

IRISH ARCHITECTURAL ARCHIVE

AT THE IRISH ARCHITECTURAL ARCHIVE IN DUBLIN, A DATABASE OF IRISH architects and their works is being compiled. The project was described in the *Bulletin of the Irish Georgian Society*, xxxvi (1994) 75-77. Since that article was written, inputting has reached the letter H. There has also been a slight contraction of the date range. The rather arbitrary range of 1700-1950 has been changed to 1720-1940. 1720 has been preferred as being the date at which Rolf Loeber's *A biographical dictionary of architects in Ireland 1600-1720* (1981) ends, and 1940 as reflecting the natural break in architectural and building activity in Ireland caused by the Second World War.

The following list is of persons included in the database whose names begin with the letter C. It includes some engineers and some builders and craftsmen. The symbol * following the name indicates a builder or craftsman; the symbol # indicates a foreigner – usually English or Scottish – who carried out work in Ireland but was never based in this country. Dates of birth and death are given, when known, followed by the quarter centuries in which the subject is believed to have been active professionally.

Carroll, a Dublin architect, won the competition for the courthouse in 1874.

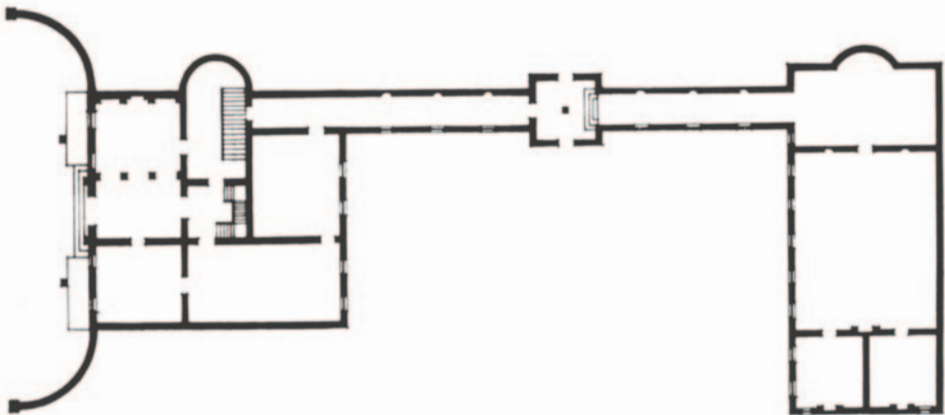
3 – Richard Castle, Bellinter, Co Meath (1750-)

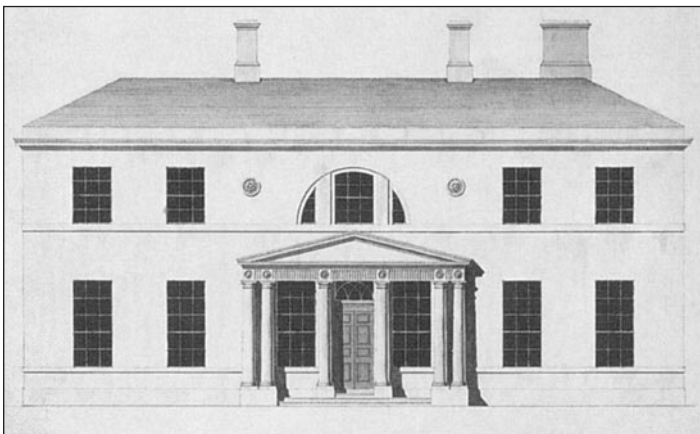


6 – Thomas Cooley, Royal Exchange, Dublin (1769-)
